Upcoming: Site Data Management Reports Data Visualization

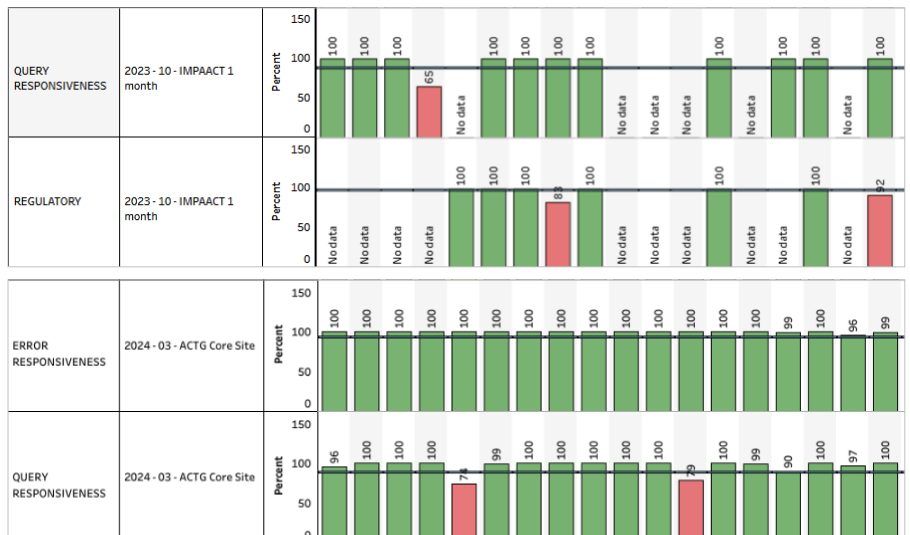

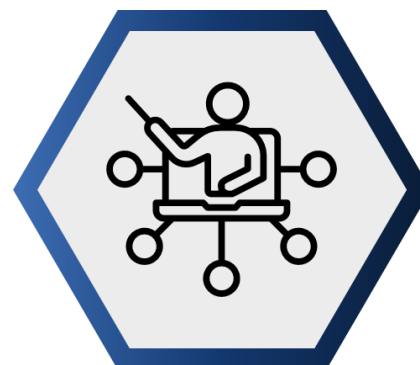


DMC Virtual Introductory Workshop

Where are you from?
