Welcome to the 2026 IMPAACT Annual Meeting

Dear Meeting Participants:

Welcome to the 2026 International Maternal Pediatric Adolescent AIDS Clinical Trials Network (IMPAACT) Annual Meeting! We are thrilled to bring together investigators, community partners, and collaborators from around the world for what promises to be an engaging and meaningful few days of science, connection, and shared purpose.

The 2026 program displays the breadth and vitality of IMPAACT’s scientific mission. Our Community Sessions on June 4 and 5 set the stage for the full meeting, featuring conversations on next-generation HIV therapy, aging with HIV, and more. On Tuesday, we open with a State of the Network address and a fireside discussion with Dr. Robert Eisinger on NIAID priorities, followed by updates from NICHD by Dr. Rohan Hazra, and a panel discussion on implementation science and its integration into the IMPAACT scientific agenda. Wednesday brings Scientific Committee and Scientific Core presentations from the Cure and Immunotherapy, Therapeutics, Tuberculosis, Brain and Mental Health, and Social Behavioral Scientific committees. Three early career investigators will also share their research – a reminder that the next generation of IMPAACT science is already well underway. Thursday’s plenary features a methodological session on trial designs and study updates from IMPAACT 2042 (Tatelo Plus), IMPAACT 2034, IMPAACT 2046 (UPLIFT), and IMPAACT 2010 (VESTED).

As the end of our current grant cycle approaches, this meeting offers a moment to reflect on what the IMPAACT Network has accomplished and to look ahead. The studies, science, and community relationships on display this week are a testament to what collaborative, participant-centered research can achieve. We are energized by the work underway and committed to carrying that momentum into the next cycle, ensuring that IMPAACT remains at the forefront of research on HIV, TB, and other co-occurring conditions for pregnant and postpartum women, infants, children, and adolescents for years to come.
